

SCISOC EXECUTIVE ELECTION 2026 – WRIT OF ELECTION

Whereas pursuant to article 1.6 of the Science Society Elections Protocol (here after referred to as the Electoral Code), the Vice President Internal shall issue a Writ of Election.

Be it hereby known that the campaign period shall be from March 23rd 12:00 AM EST to April 6th 11:59 pm EST.

Pursuant to section 3, article 1.1 of the Constitution, the positions available are:

SciSoc Executives:

- One (1) President
- One (1) Vice President Internal
- One (1) Vice President External
- One (1) Vice President Operations
- One (1) Vice President Academic
- One (1) Vice President Communications
- One (1) Vice President Programming
- One (1) Vice President Wellness

Expense Limits:

Campaign expenses shall be restricted to no more than \$100 each for all candidates. The expenses incurred during the campaign are non-refundable.

Qualifications:

According to article 3.3 of the Electoral Code, all candidates, in order to be eligible for any of the above-mentioned positions, must be undergraduate students registered in the Faculty of Science at Carleton University.

According to article 3.3.3 of the Electoral Code, President candidates must also be 18 years of age and have experience in the Science Society as an executive or as an executive member of any departmental society.

Nominations:

The nomination form will be made available as of Monday, March 9th at 12:00AM EST and due on Sunday, March 22nd at 11:59PM EST. Nominees will need 10 endorsements from any undergraduate student registered in the Faculty of Science.

Voting days will be on Tuesday, April 7th and Wednesday, April 8th 2026.

All nomination requirements must be submitted to the Elections Officer no later than the end time stated above. The nomination form (Google Forms) may be obtained on the SciSoc website at sciencesociety.ca, or via the link in the bio of the official SciSoc Instagram, @carletonscisoc.
