Whereas pursuant to article 1.6 of the Science Society Elections Protocol (hereafter referred to as the Electoral Code), the Vice President Internal shall issue a Writ of Election.

Be it hereby known that the campaign period shall be from April 15th to April 21st 11:59 pm EST.

Pursuant to section 3, article 1.1 of the Constitution, the positions available are:

One (1) Vice President Communications

One (1) Vice President Programming

One (1) Vice President Wellness

Expense Limits:

Campaign expenses shall be restricted to no more than \$100 each for all candidates. The expenses incurred during the campaign are non-refundable.

Qualifications:

According to article 3.3 of the Electoral Code, all candidates, in order to be eligible for any of the above-mentioned positions, must be undergraduate students registered in the Faculty of Science at Carleton University.

According to article 3.3.3 of the Electoral Code, President candidates must also be 18 years of age and have experience in the Science Society as an executive or as an executive member of any departmental society.

Nominations:

The nomination form will be made available as of Tuesday, April 9th at 12:00AM EST and due on Friday, April 12th at 11:59PM EST. Nominees will need 10 endorsements from any undergraduate student registered in the Faculty of Science.

Voting days will be on Monday, April 22nd and Tuesday, April 23rd 2024.
